On the occasion of Nepalese New Year 2066 B. S., Crocodile Conservation Awareness Project (CCAP) published one thousand copies of wall calendars and these are being distributed free to the local people, students, teachers and different relevant governmental and non-governmental organizations in Nepal. The calendar has 4 pages and each page contains three months. The half of each page has been occupied by the pictures and message of conservation and the remaining area is occupied by national/local festivals, holidays, national and international days. The green days (different conservation days) are highlighted. Some of the photographs of activities during the first RSG project are also printed to increase awareness and motivate the people to participate in crocodile conservation initiatives. The RSGF logo along with the contact details of the team leader has also been published.
