Project Update: October 2008

On 6 October 2008. we have a group of 25 students participated from the following local schools:

- Phoo Kao Thong school
- Baan Kamphuan school
- Dome Thong school
- Damrangsart school

This group has done the following activities:

- Mr.Phanuwachr, KCLC's Director explained the RSG project to them.
- Observed the seeds of Mangrove species that the UCLA students, Birmingham University students and women and fisher-folk group planted in July, August and September 2008 respectively.
- They all prepared the soil bags.
- Searched for the seeds of new Mangrove species, they could find 7 more new species.
- Finally, we are able to collect totally 20 mangrove species.





The following are all the 20 species (seeds) we found:
