This half month report shows a hands-on learning program for local women group of Suksamran district and young fisherfolk, the activities aim to increase stakeholders' awareness and direct practice of increasing and maintaining the biodiversity of the natural mangrove habitat and associated species adjacent to Laem Son National Park. This group of 25 attendants have done the following activities:

- Mr. Phanuwachr, KCLC's Director explained the RSG project to them.
- Observed the seeds of Mangrove species that the UCLA and Birmingham University students planted in July and August 2008.
- They all prepared the soil bags.
- Searched for the seeds of new Mangrove species, they could find 5 more new species. Up to now we are able to collect totally 13 mangrove species.
