Project Update: April 2014

I write to update you on activities regarding the continuation of the Wonegizi Youth Environmental Rights Awareness & Education Training Program currently been implemented in 10 communities and schools in Ziama Clan, Lofa County, Liberia. SADS field team have completed the teaching circle for the environmental training booklets, along with providing adequate training for master trainers in each community schools.

During the course of SADS interaction of school kids and youth, many of them express deep interest in knowing a better and environmentally friendly ways of carrying out their agriculture activities. In this regard, we work along with the Ministry of Agriculture local team, CARE- Liberia and Fauna and Flora International (Liberia team) to develop a simple training booklet on Conservation Agriculture. This has gone through series of peer review, and is currently been test in two of the project schools.

SADS intend to use this as means of increasing the knowledge and practices of rural youth, students and women in conservation and climate smart agriculture activities in their respective communities.

This testing phase should climax the completion of activities under this grant, and an end of project activities report will be submitted subsequently.
