Project Update: February 2012

Survey has been conducted in Amberbaken District approximately 59 km from Manokwari, a capital city of West Papua Province. So far, 73 respondents have been interviewed related to hunting activities conducted in the site. Data on hunting were collected during the site visit to Amberbaken District. We need to modify questionnaire for socio economic study because it takes longer than the expected time. It is also hard for the respondents to answer the questionnaire during the adjustment period. Fortunately, secondary data from previous study around the site were available and it was used for supporting information. Wildlife population density (in particular hunting target) survey is now planning, because volunteer students from Universitas Negeri Papua will be involved in this part. Socio economic data from Abun District is now collecting using the modified questionnaire. Feedback from this site will be used to collect data on other site (Amberbaken District).
