

Project Update: October 2015

The Urban Green Rhinos Program is well underway across the country! Seven hundred middle school students have taken part in a seminar and activity session on local biodiversity. Nine school teams, four in Siliguri and five in Kolkata, have begun planning their conservation projects. Some projects that students have chosen this year include monitoring city trees and their associated animals; a survey of butterfly diversity in an urban area and monitoring the health of small water bodies in the area around the school. One group of students has chosen to try their hand at fund raising for environmental causes in their city. We have a set of very committed, excited young people who are ready to make their visions for clean, green cities come true!
