

Project Update: December 2015

Green Fins (GF) continues to pave the way to unite politics and sustainability for marine conservation at diving popular destinations around the world.

Reef-World team joined the GF Malaysia team in KL in a workshop to review and finalised an Action Plan for the Malaysian Government to deliver on their international commitments to Aichi Target 10 under the Convention of Biological Diversity (CBD).

The Aichi Biodiversity Targets are a set of 20, time-bound, measureable targets agreed by the 193 Parties to the CBD in Nagoya, Japan, in October 2010.

GF, as a management approach which has already been adopted by the national government, was identified as a key tool for addressing many of the ecological threats posed by the active tourism industry inside and outside the national MPAs.

The Action Plan will be finalised and implemented under the 11th National Plan of the Malaysian Government 2016 – 2020 and will see GF become even more firmly grounded within coastal resource management in Malaysia.
