Project Update: October 2012

Workshop on Alerce forests in rural schools.

We developed six workshops directed to children from rural schools located in areas associated to the historical exploitation of Alerce. The main objective of these workshops was to educate small children about the main ecological features and the importance of this species beyond its value as wood. The workshops were developed in the following schools and involved more than 120 students in total:
