

Project Update: February 2013

The information and education programme was a key activity in January – March 2013. We prepared and published a second issue of illustrated leaflet “Rare and endemic plants of the Magadan Region”. Six endemic plants of the vicinity of Magadan were describe and illustrated in detail: *Salix magadanensis*, *Pedicularis ochotensis*, *Astragalus vallicoides*, *Primula mazurenkoeae*, *Bupleurum atargense*, and *Corydalis magadanica*. The photos of five rarest endemic plants from difficult to access areas of the Magadan region were added to the leaflet. This leaflet was granted to Ecological Center for Teenagers and to the Visit Center of Magadan State Nature Reserve. We prepared wall exhibition from our scientific materials for ecological education of schoolchildren. Several leaflets were distributed to tourists, hunters and fisherman during questioning on area of distribution of rare plants.

Besides, we were processing data from our investigation of threatened plants population biology obtained during field season in 2012. Phenology observations are under continuation in our model plots.
