

Project Update: January 2013

We changed from use of saw dust in the pig pens to use of concrete, the reason being that our pigs where not tolerating wetness and coldness during rainy season as too much rain would leave the place in wet conditions hence leading to death of babies. Being in the tropics, rain is heavy and pigs cannot withstand constant wetness. So the new design is that we shall correct all the waste generated, heap it together, add indigenous micro-organisms corrected for the purposes of degrading it and making it less harmless to the environment.

This is important for enriching soil fertility and nutrient recycling as opposed to burying them in the pig pens for years.
