Project Update: October 2013

We launched the project in the Native Community of Infierno with talks in the Hermoza Grande Elementary School about the conservation and importance of parrots and macaws for the ecosystem and for the community itself. The talks had a good reception by the children and by the teachers as this was the first time when they heard about these issues in more details. We also shared some school materials among the children, they painted macaws and parrots. There were many questions by the teachers and the parents. As the next step we presented a plan for various field courses teaching the children about parrots and their conservation in the field. Coordination is in progress with the school.

We also started to gather information about parrot and macaw nest locations in the community.
