Project Update: August 2013

This is the third report on the project. The third field trip (7 days) was done in Ulcinj, Ada Bojana and Sasko Lake.

The final field work was supposed to take place in September 2013 but was rescheduled for August 2013 due to the obligations of the project team in September.

We visited Sasko Lake and 10 ponds near Velika Plaza (Ulcinj) and Ada Bojana. We found Balkan terrapin at two ponds only, probably due to the high daytime temperatures. Current threat to this species in Ulcinj is illegal dumping of solid waste. Participation in the workshop took a representative of Serbian Herpetological Society.
