

Project Update: July 2016

In accordance with planned project activities we have implemented following activities in June and July 2016.

- In June 2016, we conducted four field mycological research trips in different parts of Bosnia and Herzegovina (area nearby city of Olovo, Donji Vakuf municipality and upper Vrbas valley, collect some first valuable data from Livanjsko karst field, and finished with locality Javornik, mountain Igman near Sarajevo).
- In July 2016, we have finished three field research trips so far. We started the month with research activities and inventory of Pezizales on the mountains Bjelašnica and Visočica, continued with field activities in the far northwestern part of Bosnia and Herzegovina - Krajina (municipality Bihać – National Park Una, Bosanska Krupa and Sanski Most) and implemented a successful survey in the area around special nature reserve – virgin forest Trstionica near city of Kakanj.
