Project Update: July 2013

REPORT OF THE TEACHER-TRAINING NATURE CONSERVATION WORKSHOP.

Thirty-five participants were in attendance, including five university undergraduates, on industrial training to the A.P Leventis Research Institute. The aim of the workshop was to increase the number and capacity of teachers in nature conservation teaching. Various issues relating to nature and conservation were taught and discussed, and updates of school nature clubs appraised. Challenges facing school projects were also discussed, and possible solutions and ideas shared. The high point of the meeting was the formation of a school network of nature clubs to help in information dissemination, idea sharing and environmental communication platforms. Certificates of participation were awarded to each participant at the end of the workshop.
