Project Update: March 2015

During December 2014, we travelled to San Agustin de Valle Fértil in order to perform the taxonomic identification class of the material collected by the students throughout the year. Afterwards the specimens were stored in three entomological boxes and the arthropods collection was donated to the school along with all the material needed to sample, identify and store. With all the data obtained during the project, we have created four posters and 400 pamphlets that today are information material for tourists in the reserve interpretation office at the park entrance. In addition, the educative programme has been incorporated into the school curricula for its continuity throughout 2015. Currently, a technical report with the diversity indices of the different sample locations in the natural park is underway in order to be delivered to the Province Environmental Agency.
