

Project Update: December 2013

Remote analyses of fish community by GoPro cameras

High definition GoPro cameras are been used to analyse reef fish community associated with the fire-coral (*Millepora* spp.) in Tamandaré reefs. Species behaviour and also competition progress are been analysed by the remote cameras during this project.

Moreover, new cameras provided for the Reef Conservation Project will be used for a study in the Formozo river estuary (North of Tamandaré). Cameras will be installed in different positions of the estuary and also different structure types (artificial vs natural) to correlate the use of estuarine and reef species in different locations.
