Project Update: September 2015

We are conducting field activities to record data related to trails, historical sites and bird watching posts in the field. These data are important for us to stimulate outdoor activities, enabling us to design possible tourism patterns within the park. All geographic information has been collecting to provide an overview of the ecotourism program in Bu Gia Map National Park.

While collecting data in the field, we encourage local people to participate in these activities. Villagers are familiar with forests, wildlife habitats and trails, enabling them to participate in tourism activities for years to come. As a result, local people are now able to independently conduct activities in the field, meaning that they have a better understanding of tourism within the park. This enables them to introduce and guide visitors if necessary. Understanding the ecotourism potentials enables us to develop community-based programs in Bu Gia Map National Park.
