Project Update: July 2014

This project has 85% completion of its three component parts. Two mangrove stands were chosen for study after a reconnaissance survey: one with a near natural condition located in Elokato (5°18′04′′N & 3° 44′ 08′′W) and a disturbed stand located in the Anan-Agban (5° 18′ 38′′N & 3° 51′35′′W).

Physical habitat assessment

Vegetation structures of the two stands have been determined. The study protocol was modified due to the dense nature of the mangrove forest.

Soil/Water analyses

A new dimension of seasonality have been added to this study aspect. Water samples from the lagoon and the adjoining water wells were analysed for their main ionic constituents.

Socio-economic survey

Work on this aspect has been concluded.
