

Project Update: May 2015

From January till May 2015 I presented the project results in two elementary schools and three high schools in Sarajevo Canton. In May 2015, I completed the presentation of the project to students of all semesters at Biology Department of Faculty of Science and Mathematics in Sarajevo. On Facebook the group: "Ants of Bosnia and Herzegovina" has more than 100 members. Also I sent scientific article regarding diversity and ecology of wood ants in Bosnia-Herzegovina in Forestry Journal and till final report I will have confirmation of acceptance. Mountaineering societies were not interested in oral presentations, so I distributed promotional material in mountain houses and offices of mountaineering associations.

Till end of June 2015 an appointment with the Director of the Protected Areas in Canton Sarajevo will be held. I expect to get support to continue research of wood ants in the Protected Areas in Canton Sarajevo. At that meeting I will arrange the placement of promotional boards in a protected area of the waterfall "Skakavac".
