1. **LAUNCHINGS SEASON WHALES (August)** include departing to the sea for whale watching and audio-visual projections in three communities:


- 1.1. <u>Piriapolis (Thursday 14)</u>: whale watching trip and lunch invited by the local Restorn Aerosillas.
