

Project Update: August 2015

The past 3 months have been an exciting period of conservation work for us comprising 10 community forest forums organized, community indigenous tree nurseries established for provision of tree seedlings for ecological restoration and enrichment planting in the 10 sacred forests and other community farmlands and forest plantations field survey efforts interspersed with community work and conservation education. The highlights of our RSG project over this period has been the establishment of a nursery at the Mafia C and at least 10,000 indigenous tree species planted within sacred forest and biological stock enriched. In the coming months, our conservation efforts will focus mostly on Natural resources vision framework developed with the sacred forests resource as the focus for Mafia C landscape Forest protection and sustainable management plan/framework developed with rules and regulations to protect the 10 sacred forests and improve forest management in the traditional area.
