

Project Update: October 2015

No bird tracking was commenced in the first year of the project (2014/2015), because the 5 gram satellite transmitters we ordered are just now in the process of testing, and will be shipped around December 2015. Therefore, in addition to the observations of the population and daily movements of our target species- spotted greenshank in the intended capture sites, we will attempt to capture the birds in January 2016 in two areas, Prasae, Rayong province and Laem Phak Bia, Phetchaburi province, which our data suggests hold the largest overwintering populations of spotted greenshank in Thailand.

Our survey results also indicated that there were more spotted greenshank roosting ponds recorded, therefore we will have more locations and more opportunities for capturing birds during this migration season (2015/2016).
