Project Update: November 2015

The research was completed successfully with the help of funding from your organization, supports from the taxonomic experts, agencies and communities in the country. This research has established the baseline information for the study area which will enable to understand future changes in the freshwater aquatic community.

The Research had involved the students from College of Natural Resources, forestry staff from Park, territorial divisions and communities. The finding were presented to students and faculty of College of Natural Resources. A poster presentation was also made during 3rd annual Bhutan Ecological Symposium in capital, Thimphu.

The paper will be published in annual Journal of Bhutan Ecological Society in December 2015. Presently the paper is in the process of reviewing by the board of editors.

Through this research i have gained experiences and enhanced skills and knowledge, and now i am confident to continue with this work to document the aquatic biodiversity in the Country and further collaborate with the Hindu-Kush Himalayan experts to explore the taxonomic level to Genus and species in future
