Project Update: May 2008

The project continued with the erection of the prohibitive information sign posts at the vantage points in all the project area to help educate the general public on the conservation and protection of the marine turtle species.

Community turtle conservation education was focused on the fishermen at the beaches in all the project areas to help sharpen their understanding on the ecological significance of marine turtles and the need to protect them in order to sustain their fishing livelihoods.

The monitoring activities at the project area beaches revealed a number of interesting scenes which includes helping the hatchlings find their way into the natural environment (sea) at Akosua Village beach.
