Project Update: February 2016

I have finished the ultrasonic data collection for aerial insectivorous bats' assemblage in forest sites, in treefall gaps and in oil palm plantations. In both seasons, I got simultaneous recordings in all sites during the complete sampling period. In the first field trip (dry season), I obtained large amount of data, meanwhile in the second trip (rainy season), I got less data. It is necessary to mention that seasonal rains were delayed until November 2015. It is important to consider this for the discussion of the results.

I have started to work on the arrangement of data for its analysis. The next step is to give talks to children at primary school about the project and the importance of bats and its conservation.
