

Project Update: August 2016

We have monitored latrine sites of small-clawed otter in rice fields. Based on the monitoring, we found several latrine sites as the most visited sites. Furthermore, we set up camera traps in two latrine sites. We found at least five individuals in a group. All of their photos were recorded in night. We are still recording them by using the camera. In these latrine sites we set up soft-catch traps and box traps. We successfully trapped an otter by using box trap, and then installed transmitter to the animal. This animal is the first radio-tagged otter in Indonesia. We are tracking it now.
