Project Update: December 2015

We made the first planting of 120 seedlings of *Kageneckia lanceolata*, in Vaquerías Nature Reserve (64º 26' W, 31º 06' S, between 700 and 1200 m asl) on the western slope of the Sierra Chica of Córdoba. In an abandoned quarry and an adjacent site. We are testing different restoration techniques (fertiliser application (N: P: K), watering and facilitation).

Also we continue the volunteering in University Campus (<u>https://www.facebook.com/BosqueNativoUnc/</u>). And we perform an activity for children to learn to do seedlings of native species and recognise the major environmental problems in the province of Cordoba, Argentina.
