Project Update: October 2007

We visited "Pehuen Có" and "Monte Hermoso" coastal cities, during October of 2007. These sites are placed at southwestern of Buenos Aires Province and constitute essential sites for make conservation actions for Sand dune lizard and their habitat. The sand dunes in these places are in relatively good conservation status and are included into a "Grassland Valuable Area" for South America.

The work included research surveys of Sand dune lizard and activities of diffusion and education.



November 2007

We visited "Mar del Tuyu" coastal city, during November of 2007. These sites are placed at North East of Buenos Aires Province. Although man made disturbance on this site is high, Sand dune lizard still inhabit in this dunes. The local people are very interested for make conservation activities.

The work included diffusion and education activities in schools.



December 2007 - January 2008

Now, we are working at "Mar Chiquita Provincial Park". This Park placed at Central East of Buenos Aires Province. This is one of the main sites for Sand dune lizard conservation. MCPP is the only area that makes an effective protection of lizards and their habitat. This site also be declared like Grassland Valuable Area for South America

The work includes research activities principally.
