

Project Update: May 2016

During late autumn of 2015 and winter of 2015/2016, we have published brochure and poster about role and conservation of fen mires with their avifauna and about the project. We need these handout materials in order to share information about our target species and habitats among wide auditory, especially among hunters and some local communities in the vicinity to study sites. Apart of that, we have conducted a lecture for hunters which took place at the local annual meeting of hunting society and some meetings with small groups. All this in whole should lay good basement for successful implementation of the project during its main implementation period in late spring and summer. Our pilot visits to the study area revealed that development of early spring in west Ukraine promises good breeding season for studied waders (great and common snipes, Eurasian curlew) in April-June 2016 because in comparison to previous 2 years, spring is quite warm and level of precipitation is normal.
