

Project Update: February 2016

Questionnaire format has been developed as per the objectives. Three school dropouts from Eusu block was selected for the survey. Survey protocol and data collection training was conducted with the school dropouts and the staff of Jigme Khesar Strict Nature Reserve. From the total numbers of households 157 with livestock holding within 5 years was identified for questionnaire survey. 50% of the households were randomly selected by the random number sample from five Chewogs under Eusu block. 54 households have been surveyed as of now under Eusu block. Currently doing with the livestock holding household sorting and school dropout selection with the local government of Sangbaykha block.
