We observed two male elephants at one of the village tanks one evening. We believe that they were hiding in the village forest patches until dark. In the same day elephants came to the experimental paddy land at dawn and raided after breaking the private



electric fence. On the other hand elephants still break the park electric fence at dawn to return the park and we are struggling to find their entering places to the village.
