Sea Grass Beds

During the last week of June 2016 we conducted the third educational workshop at the Guatemalan Caribbean. Through different activities, children were trained about seagrass beds, the importance of this ecosystem, associated key species, and main threats for the region.

After the workshop, children made their own drawings of their favourite animal that lives in the seagrass beds, and together, we created a collage at the schools. Children's favourite marine animal appear to be the sea star!

Using the "sustainable fishing" game, children got to know what species are good to be fished and the importance of release the juveniles or animals that humans don't eat, this in order to maintain our fish populations, and to have fish for the future.
