

Project Update: May 2016

The second class of environmental education in schools at the Guatemalan Caribbean was from the 17th to 19th May 2016. The topic was “Main threats of mangroves and possible solutions”, which were identified by the children. Workshops were held in two public schools: El Quetzalito and Creek Chino, reaching an audience of 400 children of primary school. For this, we did several educational dynamics such as puppet shows, storyteller, educational books about mangroves and teams to determine the threats and solutions of this ecosystem. We also donated 400 story books titled “Timmy el cangrejo explorador: experiencia mágica por el manglar” in both schools.
