Project Update: November 2016

As planned, I have done primate and vegetation surveys in the Los Tuxtlas and Uxpanapa regions. Interestingly, in the Uxpanapa region I found two albino individuals of howler monkeys (*Alouatta palliata mexicana*), one adult female and one infant, who appeared to be the son of a non-albino adult female (see attached photos). They were recorded in a small fragment (less than 10 ha), bordered by pasture and orange crops.

Currently, I am analysing digital maps to estimate all predictor variables (landscape structure metrics) of these two regions and next year I will sample the Lacandona and V Norte regions.

All field and laboratory works is progressing as planned.
