Finally, we released the short film on dolphin-fisher conflict that was produced with support from Rufford. I completed filming 2 years ago, however, I required a lot of technical support to put the story together. Ongi, shot in the Palk Bay and Gulf of Mannar in Ramanathapuram district of Tamil Nadu, traces the conflict between humpback dolphins and artisanal fisheries. It journeys into the lives of artisanal fishers, who share a common narrative of displacement and loss of fishing livelihoods, to reveal how and why this conflict occurs.
