

Project Update: November 2016

We have now completed our second sampling expedition, collecting about 40 fish species. We recorded threatened species (*Brycon nattereri*, *Ancistrus minutus*), endemic and recently described fish (*Retroculus acherontos*, photo), and some still undescribed ones such as (*Pseudopimelodus aff. pucher*), probably a new genus of miniature catfish of the family Pseudopimelodidae. We continued our education program by visiting rural properties of the area, and scheduled visits to local schools.

Finally, we developed our website with information about fish species of the Cerrado biome, other animals, registration forms for rural and touristic properties and other people interested in collaborating with the preservation of water resources.
