Project Update: October 2016

During June, July, August and September 2016 we had we had lots of activities with great results.

- Snake exhibition that we organised in Podgorice, Montenegrin capital, had great results. During 5 days of exhibition, over 6000 people visited, the five biggest TV houses made a reportage about exhibition and, in cooperation with Montenegrin Natural History Museum, we organised lectures during the days of exhibition.
- Fieldwork activities continued during these months, and we confirmed presence of *V.ursinii* on mountain Prokletije, and reconfirmed it on mountain Lukavica after more than 30 years, on the way to Krnovo. Unfortunately, during our research we still didn't confirm *V.ursinii* on Orjen.
- Because of the tense situation between governments of Montenegro and Kosovo, and because of minor clashes of locals, we couldn't visit mountain Mokra, that is on border between Montenegro and Kosovo.
- Several workshops with children were done, where we stand out workshop in TQ Capital Plaza in Podgorica, where, during 8 hours of workshop, more than 20 groups of children visited us.
- Also, "Open days of science 2016"were again successful and our workshop "snakes are friends "was again declared the most visited workshop on Faculty of mathematics and science.
