

Project Update: July 2016

We have begun netting and ringing for the project at Danum Valley Field Centre. Six plots have been established and netting transects set up within each one. Netting and data collection have been very productive so far, and more than 200 hundred birds have been captured already. As well, we have had about 100 recaptured individuals, which are crucial to understanding bird movement. Numbers of recaptures should increase as we ring and release more birds over the study season. Highlights so far include some rare and reclusive species, such as blue-headed and banded pitta, cinnamon-rumped and scarlet-rumped trogon, and white-tailed blue flycatcher.
