

## Project Update: October 2016

Following the proposed activity schedule, we first met the local team of the NGO Neotropica do Brasil and got in touch with some farmers to show our project to them and plan the field logistics. We sampled dragonflies at 44 sites in the Bodoquena region. As first results (10% of identified specimens), we highlight the first records of two species for the state of Mato Grosso do Sul (*Phyllogomphoides suspectus* and *Oligoclada abbreviata limnophila*). To date, we have sequenced 64 Odonata species. We also created a logo which will be added on the website and all materials for the project. The next step is to identify all the collected specimens and build the website. The figures below show some activities in the field and the logo illustration as well.
