

Project Update: June 2010

In April, May and June 2010, the project team was very busy developing environmental education and awareness materials. By end of May, the project team developed 1,500 posters, 1,000 leaflets and 600 simple calendars that were distributed to 27 schools, 16 offices and 750 stakeholders that live in the project area. The aim of distributing these environmental materials is to assist in increasing knowledge among local communities and other stakeholders in the importance of protecting and conserving our wildlife and why it is important to take active part in conservation of the animals. It is estimated that about 2,000 people have gained knowledge on the protection of wildlife from these materials. In addition, school pupils and local communities were also entertained to drama performed by Anali Kuti Troupe Theatre. This was another vehicle for disseminating environmental messages to a wider section of the society.
