Project Update: October 2016

The specimen collection of monsoon and post monsoon have been completed as reflected in the time schedule despite a little adjustment that had to made due to the heavy rainfall. The specimens collected are almost all identified. Although few specimens need some more time, the final list will be submitted once all of it gets identified. However, many of the collected specimens have been identified till the family level. The data analysis and the discussions with expertise are being carried out.
