Visit to Khamda-Dev plateau

On 3rd October 2017 field visit was conducted for Chaukul High School students to tell them about plant diversity of lateritic plateau. A total of 48 students of 8th and 9th Standard and their teachers visited Khamda- Dev plateau (One of the plateaus of Chaukul) and explored the plant diversity. Students could learn plants as well as their ecological adaptations, plant-animal interactions, etc. During this visit students collected the plants, they asked so many questions and they were very enthusiastic to know all these things.
