Project Update: January 2018

In January 2018, we finalised our second field work phase, having successfully discussed the results of the ecosystem service mapping with a various local stakeholders in the cities of Bragança and Tracuateua. In ca. 20 interviews and workshops, we asked about the fishing grounds, potential tourism areas, bird nesting sites, and other areas where relevant ecosystem services take place (supply areas). We also talked about were users come from (demand areas) for each service provided by the mangroves and nearby coastal waters. By connecting supply and demand, we are now able to establish, for example, mobility patterns for the fishing activities in the region.



During the workshops we also received feedback on the awareness-raising brochure, including the map produced. We updated the material with the suggestions made and are now producing a second print run with 2,000 copies, which will be distributed to local users in the next few months.
