

Project Update: February 2017

We have conducted 11 field samplings (November 2016 to January 2017) to record the interactions between frugivorous birds and plants. To date, we have recorded 44 different interactions of frugivory among 28 bird species and five plant species. We found, that the species of plant *Ficus cotinifolia* is that interacts with the largest number of birds, and the golden-fronted woodpecker (*Melanerpes aurifrons*) is that feeds on more fruit species. Also, during field sampling, have been photographed the interactions between the birds and plants to elaborate the field guide. In addition, we have been preparing the didactic material and organizing the meetings for conducting the environmental education workshops.
