

Project Update: August 2017

In July 2017, the survey work and data gathering have been conducted in the north sector of Mwana forest. During this field work, eight gorilla nests have been encountered, including seven fresh nests and one recent nest. Thus, the surveys work is completed throughout the Mwana forest.

It is important to mention that data collected in the north, the south and the centre sectors will be compiled and analysed in office. The monthly meetings will be held in August, September and October 2017 to allow field staff transfer data from standardised datasheet based system to a computer programme. This will help generation of qualitative and quantitative information and also facilitate communication of results to stakeholders and donor.
