Project Update: November 2017

We have set eight camera traps separated by 1 km in the entire forest fragment. Camera traps have been in the field for more than 1 month gathering photos and videos all kind of animal species, mainly mammals. Now we are processing all the information gathered and afterwards we are planning to publish the data in a local journal and to make educational activities with children at school (with the photos of the different mammal species obtained). On the other hand, we have constructed the greenhouse at school. We are now working on the development of the system to irrigate the plants. Once we have finished we are going to start planting seeds from native species in order to produce seedlings of native trees with children at school.
