Project Update: August 2017

On August 6th and 7th 2017, the seventh and eighth environmental workshops were held. During these days, communication as a key for conservation as well as the replication workshop were presented to teachers. Teachers learned what communication is and the difference between transmission and dialogue, and how to identify communication distortions when they are learning new information. The second workshop consisted in replicating all the activities and dynamics that educators learned through the programme. This was made in order to evaluate if teachers understood how to do it, and to correct them if there were any mistakes. The activities that were made are: environmental impact, natural resources classification, footprint questionnaire, and food web, energy through a food web and perception line. Teachers led their respective dynamic, while the rest of the teachers participated in each one. Evaluations of participants' knowledge, awareness, perceptions, skills, behaviours and satisfaction were applied.
