
Project Update: December 2017

Detailed study of the materials we collected revealed a number of floristic findings. The most valuable is buttercups we supposed to be *Ranunculus bongardii* actually are *R. uncinatus* which is a new species for flora of Russia. A scientific article about this and 29 other findings on the Mednyj Island is prepared for submitting to a peer-review journal.

We also made a row of presentations about the project. Yury Kopylov-Giskov, Nikita Tikhomirov and Maria Ivanova made a presentation on a scientific conference in the Moscow South-West High School No. 1543.
