Paper Title: Three New Records of Orchids from Nepal

Abstract: Three orchid species, Ania penangiana (Hook. f.) Summerh., Neottia longicaulis (King & Pantl.) Szlach., and Odontochilus elwesii C. B. Clarke ex Hook. f. (Orchidaceae) are newly reported from Nepal. Diagnostic characters, distribution notes, and a photograph are provided for each taxon.
