Project Update: June 2019

At the moment I am performing data analysis and paper writing. Also, I have presented the project to different audiences. I presented preliminary results at the international workshop "Socio-ecological systems in transition on tropical protected-non protected interfaces: a South-South sharing experience" held in Campo Grande, and organized by the University of Angers and the Federal University of Mato Grosso do Sul (UFMS).

In addition, I made a presentation about ecological thresholds, focused on the results of my review paper (http://afonet.org/wp_english/a-review-of-threshold-responses-of-birds-to-landscape-changes-across-the-world/) and the next steps of the project.
